


Balaam and the donkey

In 2 Peter 2:16 it says "but was rebuked for his own transgression; a speechless donkey spoke with human voice and restrained the prophet's madness". So in this verse we can see that it is saying a donkey without speech, spoke in a human voice and stopped the prophet who disobeyed God because of the money that was offered to him if he cursed the people of Israel.



"Rejoice greatly, oh daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, oh daughter of Jerusalem!Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is he, humbled and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey". So in this verse the event of Jesus entering the city on a donkey is already prophesied by a prophet named Zechariah and it say righteous and having salvation is he humble and mounted on a donkey so here we can see again that it say jesus is humble because he is riding a donkey. Another reason Jesus is riding on a donkey is to fulfill what the prophet Zechariah prophesied saying a great king is coming to you on a donkey.
