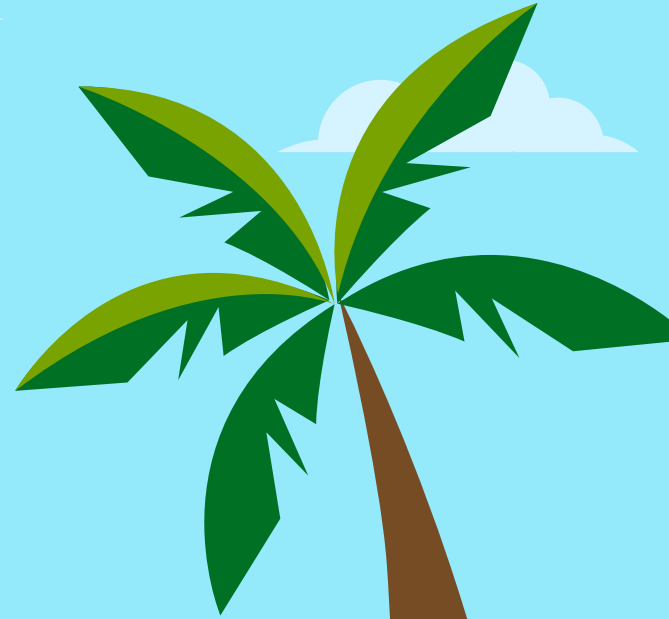
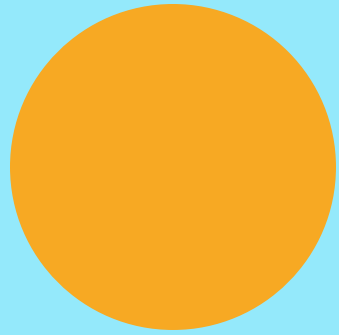


Jonah & The Whale

- After being spit out, Jonah then physically obeys the commission God gives Him





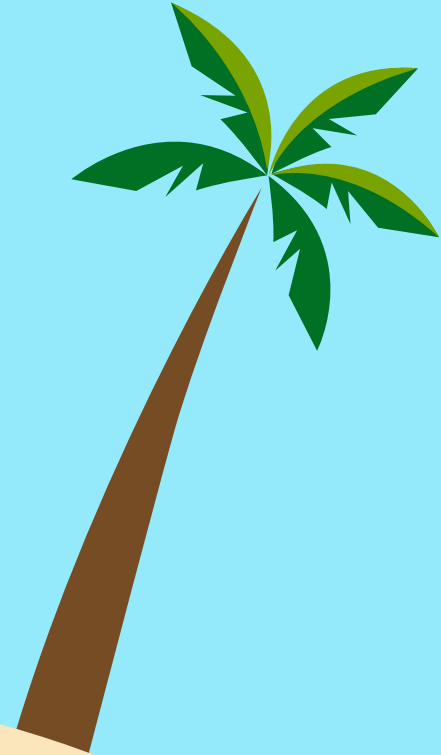
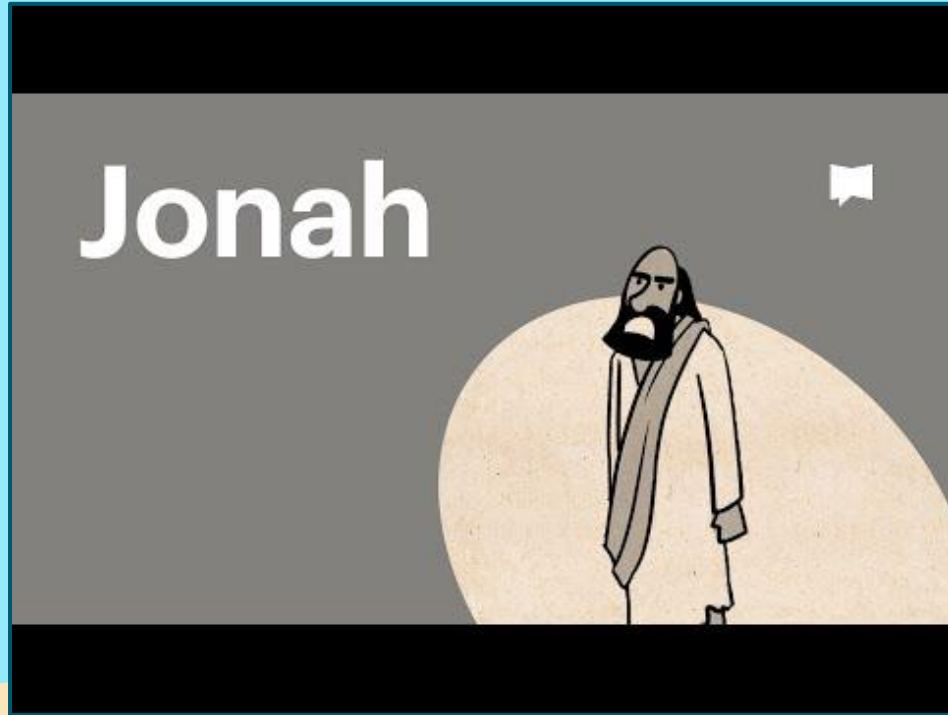
3. For Salvation
