

What you can learn by comparing Zacchaeus and the young rich man

We can learn that we need to give everything up for Jesus and follow him. In the Bible one example is Zacchaeus, you can find this story in Luke 19:1-10. We can see that Zacchaeus was a tax collector, he was a sinner.
