## The Examples of Lions



### Daniel and the Lions Den

One way Lord Jesus used lions as a help for Daniel. Daniel was thrown in the lion's den because the president and princes wanted to find fault in Daniel but they could not find anything except that daniel worships the Lord. (Daniel 6;4-5). So the president and princes tried to cheat Darius that you should only worship Darius only. Darius signed the decree and if a king signs a decree they can not take it back. (Daniel 6:10-11). They put Daniel in the lion's den. Lord Jesus used the lions and shut the mouth of all of them and nothing happened (Daniel 6:22).



#### Lion of Judah

The lion has been called the king of the beasts and the king of the jungle, and, in the Bible, Lord Jesus is called the Lion of Judah. (Revelation 5:5.) A lion generally symbolizes majesty, strength, courage, justice, and military might. So with this we see the Lord Jesus was named the Lion of Judah because he is all of the charter traits of a Lion.



#### Lamb of God

But in the Bible we see Lord Jesus is used as another animal. Lord Jesus was called the Lamb of God in (John 1:29 & 36.) Why he was called that was because it was referring Lord Jesus as the perfect and ultimate sacrifice for sin. To be called a Lamb of God means that God gave Jesus to be killed like a lamb for our sins so we could live forever. For hundreds of years, Jews brought lambs to the temple as sacrifices for their sins. They kept coming back year after year because no lamb could take away all their sin. And when Lord Jesus died for our sins he sacrificed himself for our sins. This is why Lord Jesus was named The Lamb Of God.
